BCPO IN-SERVICE TRAINING ANNOUNCEMENT

This five-day Police Training Commission certified course is designed for officers who plan to instruct at police academies and/or their respective agencies. During this day (6) day, forty eight (48) hour course, the student will learn to select appropriate teaching methods; establish goals and performance objectives; and construct lesson plans. The course will also include an overview of the principles of learning and classroom management as well as instruction in the use of various training aids including PowerPoint presentations.

Additionally, each student will be required to plan, prepare and present two lessons based on selected topics. The first is a lesson/lecture of fifteen (15) minute duration and the second is a lesson plan and lecture of thirty (30) minutes. The thirty-minute lesson plan and lecture will require the use of training aids.
